Vyrnwy Aqueduct Maintenance Programme – Upcoming work in your area

To help us continually improve the supply and quality of water we supply to customers, we're planning some work relating to our Vyrnwy Aqueduct, a section of which runs near to where you live as it continues through to Prescott in Merseyside.

We've developed a virtual exhibition at www.uuhub.com/vyrnwy to share information about our proposed maintenance on the aqueduct which will involve setting up working areas along the route of the aqueduct and installing access points from the local road network. You can also leave feedback which will be valuable as we develop our plans.

Ground investigations

Over the past few months we've been consulting and working closely with landowners and stakeholders, including your local planning and highways authorities to begin planning some important maintenance work on the aqueduct.

We've already started carrying out a number of ecological, environmental and ground investigations to assist our team with the planning. We now need to carry out further surveys to understand the ground conditions. This will involve drilling into the ground with specialist equipment - an example of the type of equipment is on the back of this letter.

How this may affect you

Our surveys will be carried out near the Shropshire Union Canal and railway line off the A49 near Beeston, and near to Lightfoot Lane within Eaton Village. Whilst some of our survey work may be visible, all of our working areas are within private land and we've planned this work with those landowners affected.

- The ground investigations will take place from 11 April 2022 and will take around 3 weeks to complete.
- Once our equipment is installed, the larger machinery will be removed from each location. However we will continue to monitor the ground for up to three months before removing any underground monitoring equipment from the area.
- All of our working areas will be fenced off for the duration of the work and all public walkways will be maintained so you will still be able to access all of the same community areas that that may use currently.

- Depending how close you are to where we're working you may notice an increase in noise and construction traffic.

We understand this type of work can be inconvenient and our team will do all they can to minimise any disruption for you and the local community and don't worry, this work will not affect your water and wastewater services which can be used as normal.

Thank you for bearing with us and we're sorry if our work gets in the way of your daily routine. As our plans for the main work develop we'll ensure we keep you updated.
