United Utilities Vyrnwy Aqueduct Maintenance Programme Update on our proposals in your area

Following on from our previous communications in April, we are writing to provide you with an update with regards to our Vyrnwy Aqueduct Maintenance Programme.

Since the launch of the Vyrnwy Aqueduct virtual exhibition webpage, we have continued to develop our proposals from the feedback received and we have worked closely with local stakeholders and landowners to confirm the feasibility of our proposals. We are now in the process of submitting planning applications for a number of our access points off the highway into private land and two applications have been submitted within Tiverton and Tilstone Parish. The applications that we have submitted include highway access applications along Tilstone Bank Road and Lodge Lane, and we anticipate that you may hear about these applications from the local council within the next few weeks.

Prior to our main works in 2023, we will be carrying out some advanced works from September 2022. This will mainly involve preparing our new access points and carrying out some ecology surveys which will enable us to begin the main works from next year.
