Vyrnwy Aqueduct Modernisation Programme – Our next stage of work in your area

To help us continually improve the quality of water we supply to customers, we'll shortly be starting the next phase of our work to modernise the Vyrnwy aqueduct, a section of which runs near to where you live, as it continues through to Prescot in Merseyside.

Members of our team will be available at Cotebrook Village Hall, Stable Lane, Cotebrook, Tarporley CW6 0JJ on Tuesday 25 June between 3:00pm and 6:30pm to share information and answer any queries.

What will our work involve?

We'll be starting work on Line 1 of the Vyrnwy Aqueduct to insert a new lining into the existing pipe. The first section of work between Tilstone Bank Road (AP1042) and Lodge Lane (AP1046) is due to start in early June and is expected to be finished in August. The section between Lodge Lane and Eaton Lane (AP1064) is expected to start in late June and take around 16 weeks to complete.

You may notice some preparation activity taking place at each of our working areas and the access point locations for our work are illustrated in the map on the reverse of this letter. Once the main construction begins there may be some periods of inactivity as our teams work at different locations along the aqueduct.

We'll provide updates as our work progresses and traffic management information will also be available at unitedutilities.com/vamp-live-updates

- Our working hours will be between 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday
- You may notice an increase in noise and construction traffic as we take delivery of large equipment, deliver new pipes, start our welding operations and begin the lining element of our work.
- Once we've completed activity at each location, we'll temporarily reinstate all our working areas and will be back in touch later this year to provide an update about work on the final pipeline (Line 2) in this area.

We understand this type of work can be inconvenient. Our team will be working closely with those who may be impacted and will do all they can to minimise any disruption. Don't worry, your water and wastewater services will not be affected and can be used as normal.
